

If an end wall requires a solid wall / privacy panel, it creates design issues.
Our preferred option is to return the glazing by one panel around the side as options 2 and 3 create details which aren't aesthetically pleasing.

Symmetrical from the outside with internal bracing on both sides of the corner post.

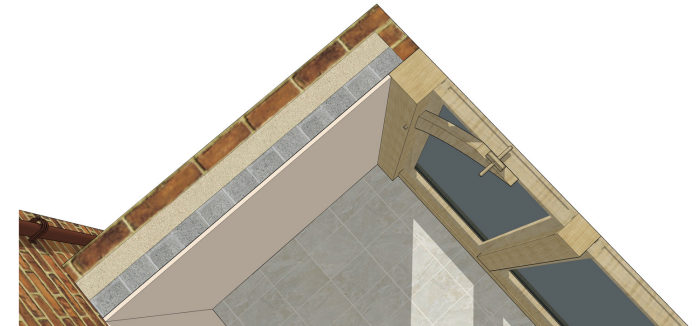
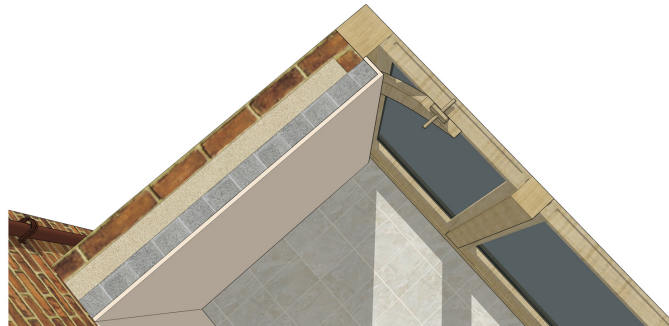
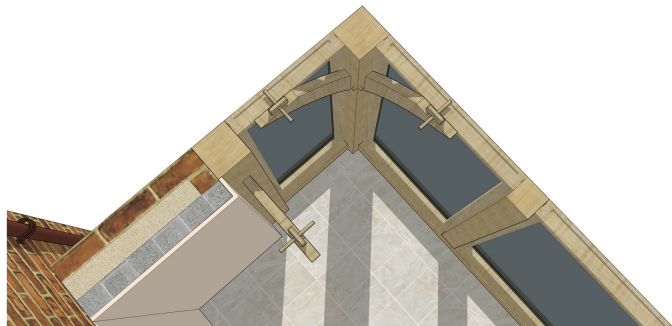


Symmetrical from the outside but creates a nasty internal corner which would be difficult to maintain and clean.
