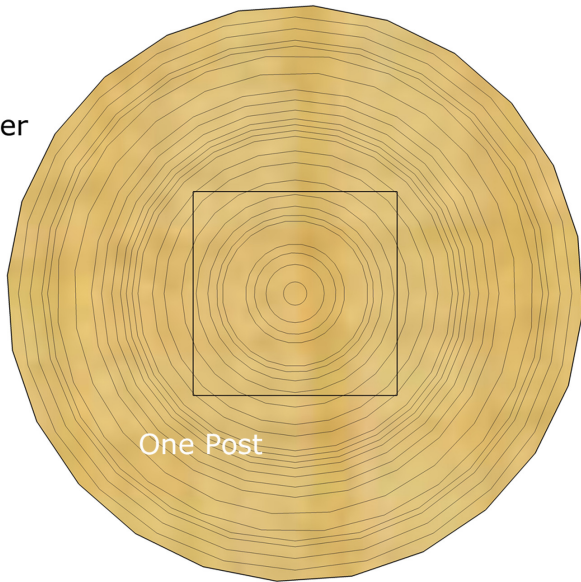
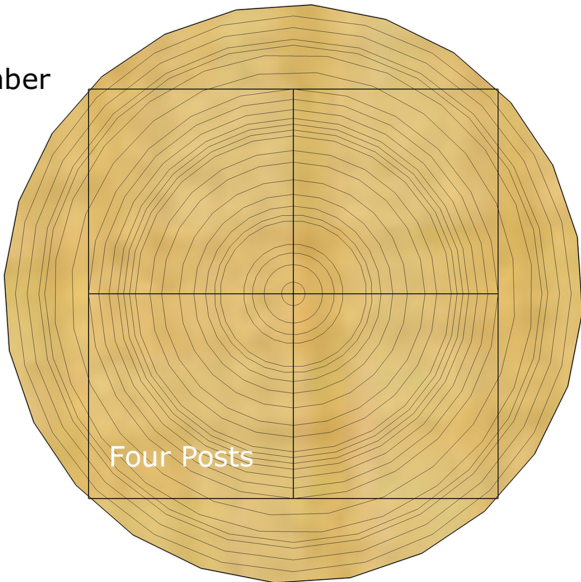


Boxed Heart Timber



One Post

Quarter Sawn Timber



Four Posts

Boxed Heart Oak, this is where the post is cut from the centre of the tree, it therefore has the same forces acting on all four sides of the post. Quarter sawn timber is much more prone to twisting along it's length.

Seasoned Oak for 'habitable' buildings such as Garden Rooms and conservatories.
Garage buildings can be done in Green Oak

Splits (Shakes) will open up in Oak but to a lesser extent in seasoned Oak. Shakes will always open against the grain. i.e. towards the centre of the tree. Quarter Sawn Timber can therefore split across the corner of the post in positions A & B which makes the post unsuitable for direct glazing systems.

Using the wrong grade & type of Oak will cause the building to leak behind the glazing unit.
